A RESOLUTION

TO CLARIFY, FOR THE FACULTY SENATE, ADMINISTRATION, FACULTY, STAFF AND SYSTEM OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE'S POSITION ON RECYCLING ISSUES EXPRESSED IN SGR No. 1

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY IS A MAJOR CONSUMER OF PAPER AND PAPER PRODUCTS, AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, A CONCERN DOES EXIST WITHIN THE UNIVERSITY COMMUNITY THAT CURRENT POLICIES AND PRACTICES WITH REGARD TO PAPER CONSUMPTION AT LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY SHOULD ENCOURAGE AN EFFICIENT USE OF RESOURCES, PARTICULARLY AS RELATED TO THE GENERATION OF WASTE AND AN ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINED USE OF RESOURCES.

PARAGRAPH 3: THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE URGES THE UNIVERSITY COMMUNITY TO PURSUE POLICIES AND PRACTICES AIMED AT A MORE EFFICIENT USE OF PAPER AND PAPER PRODUCTS AND A GREATER USE OF POST CONSUMER RECYCLED PAPER PRODUCTS.
