A BILL

TO APPROPRIATE ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000) TO THE INDIAN STUDENT ASSOCIATION OF LSU FOR ITS SPRING BANQUET TO BE HELD IN THE COTILLION BALLROOM OF THE LSU UNION ON MARCH 14, 1998.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE INDIAN STUDENT ASSOCIATION OF LSU IS

PLANNING TO HOLD A BANQUET TO PROMOTE KNOWLEDGE OF THE TRADITIONS AND CULTURE OF INDIA AND HER PEOPLE, AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, INTERACTION AMONG STUDENTS, ADMINISTRATION,

FACULTY, AND STAFF AT THE BANQUET WILL ENHANCE THE EDUCATIONAL AND SOCIAL EXPERIENCE AT LSU A&M, AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE INDIAN STUDENT ASSOCIATION OF LSU IS A

RECOGNIZED STUDENT ORGANIZATION AND HAS RAISED APPROXIMATELY TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,200) OF THE PROJECTED THREE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLAR (\$3,500) COST OF THE EVENT THROUGH MEMBERSHIP FEES, TICKET SALES, DONATIONS, AND CORPORATE SPONSORSHIP,

AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, THE INDIAN STUDENT ASSOCIATION OF LSU WILL

EXHAUST THE MONEY IT HAS ALLOCATED FOR ITS 1998 ANNUAL

SPRING BANQUET, AND

PARAGRAPH 5: WHEREAS, THE LSU A & M STUDENT GOVERNMENT SHALL BE

LISTED AS A CO-SPONSOR OF THE EVENT ACCORDING TO ARTICLE VI, SECTION 15, SUBSECTIONS A, B, AND C OF THE STUDENT

GOVERNMENT BYLAWS.

PARAGRAPH 6: THEREFORE, ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000) IS HEREBY

APPROPRIATED FROM THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY TO THE INDIAN STUDENT ASSOCIATION OF LSU TO HELP FINANCE ITS

ANNUAL CULTURAL BANQUET.

PARAGRAPH 7: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY OF

THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE. ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL

SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30, 1998.
