**A RESOLUTION**

TO RECOMMEND TO EXECUTIVE VICE-CHANCELLOR AND PROVOST DAN FOGEL,  
ROBERT DOOLOS OF THE UNIVERSITY REGISTRARS OFFICE, AND THE UNIVERSITY  
CALENDAR COMMITTEE TO BEGIN FINALS THE SATURDAY AFTER DEAD WEEK AND END  
THE FOLLOWING FRIDAY.

- PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE UNIVERSITY CURRENTLY HAS FINAL EXAMS BEGINNING ON MONDAY, MAY 11, 1998 AND ENDING ON SATURDAY, MAY 16, 1998, AND
- PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, STUDENTS WHO LIVE IN RESIDENCE HALLS ARE EXPECTED TO BE MOVED OUT ON SUNDAY, MAY 17, 1998, AND
- PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THIS BECOMES A DISTRACTION WHICH INTERFERES WITH STUDENTS' SUCCESS ON EXAMS, AND
- PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THIS PLACES A STRAIN ON STUDENTS WHO ARE FORCED TO MOVE OUT AND STUDY SIMULTANEOUSLY, AND
- PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, STUDENTS WHO LIVE OUT OF STATE ARE FORCED TO FIND STORAGE FOR PERSONAL BELONGINGS.
- PARAGRAPH 6:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE RECOMMENDS TO EXECUTIVE VICE-CHANCELLOR AND PROVOST DAN FOGEL, ROBERT DOOLOS OF THE UNIVERSITY REGISTRARS OFFICE, AND THE UNIVERSITY CALENDAR COMMITTEE TO BEGIN FINALS ON SATURDAY, MAY 9, 1998 AND END ON FRIDAY, MAY 15, 1998 TO ALLOW STUDENTS ADEQUATE TIME TO MOVE OUT OF THE RESIDENCE HALLS.
