THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE

UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE, that Student Government urges and requests Louisiana State University Procurement to allow for the funding of such a service through Student Government funding accounts or other means and that the EMS Club of LSU be added under the public safety department;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION BE SUBMITTED TO President-Interim Tom Galligan, Director of Campus Life Jacob Brumfield, Associate Vice President Brandon Commons, Chief Bart Thompson, LSU Procurement, Nelson Perret (medical director of LSU SHC), and Julie Hupperich (interim SHC executive director
