A Bill

To amend the Student Government Code

Enacted,

1 AMEND SG. Code. , tl.: 7, ch. 3 §. 204: A student, registered student
2 organization, or University Department shall only receive one Senate funding
3 allocation per semester and cannot exceed two Senate funding allocations per
4 academic year. An allocation is defined as a sponsored bill accompanied by a
5 funding request form. No part-time student may request funds from the Senate
6 with the exception of graduating seniors and graduate students.

7 TO SAY: A student or a registered student organization, excluding all
8 Student Government entities shall only receive one Senate funding allocation per
9 semester and cannot exceed two Senate funding allocations per academic year.
10 An allocation is defined as a sponsored bill accompanied by a funding request
11 form. No part-time student may request funds from the Senate with the
12 exception of graduating seniors and graduate students.

14 AMEND tl.: 7, ch. 4 § 301: All remaining funds in Student Government
15 Operating Accounts, with the exception of the College Council Surplus Account,
16 at the end of each fiscal year are transferred to the Student Government Surplus
17 Account. Senators may request surplus funds by bill. The account shall be viewed
18 as a rainy-day fund that may only be used for non-recurring expenses. The author
19 of bill should show proof of reasonable effort that other funding sources were
20 pursued for the expenditure previously. No money shall be appropriated from
21 this account for student travel. No money shall be appropriated from this account
22 for student, a registered student organization, or University department.


23 TO SAY: All remaining funds in Student Government Operating Accounts,
 24 with the exception of the College Council Surplus Account, at the end of each
 25 fiscal year are transferred to the Student Government Surplus Account. Senators
 26 may request surplus funds by bill. The account shall be viewed as a rainy-day
 27 fund that may only be used for non-recurring expenses. The author of bill should
 28 show proof of reasonable effort that other funding sources were pursued for the
 29 expenditure previously. No money shall be appropriated from this account for
 30 student travel. No money shall be appropriated from this account for student
 31 travel. No money shall be appropriated from this account for an individual
 32 student.

33 THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3)
 34 VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT,
 35 UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE
 36 PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE
 37 DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
