*To Amend the Student Government Code to provide for
Training on Diversity and Bystander Intervention, and
Suggested Cultural Enrichment Experiences
Enacted,*

1 Insert a new chapter in *Title I: General Provisions of the Student*
2 *Government Code* to read as follows:

3 **CHAPTER 6. Trainings and Cultural Enrichment**

4 **§601. Required Training**

5 ¹ All members of Student Government shall be required to complete
6 diversity training annually.

7 ² All members of Student Government shall be required to complete
8 Bystander Intervention Training during the semester if they have not
9 completed the training in the last three semesters through Student
10 Government or another organization.

11 **§602. Cultural Enrichment Opportunities**

12 ¹ In addition to the required trainings, it is recommended that members
13 of Student Government take every opportunity to enlarge their cultural
14 understanding and partake in enriching activities or trainings
15 accordingly.

17 ² The following are recommended times throughout the year at
 18 which Student Government leadership can provide said
 19 opportunities to members with examples:

20 (1) Black History Month (February)

- 21 • Lecture by African and African American
- 22 Studies Faculty;
- 23 • Events partnering with the African
- 24 American Cultural Center, Office of
- 25 Multicultural Affairs, or other student
- 26 organizations.

27 (2) Women's History Month (March)

- 28 • Women's History Lecture by Women and
- 29 Gender Studies Faculty;
- 30 • Events partnering with the LSU Center for
- 31 Gender Equity, Office of Multicultural
- 32 Affairs, or other student organizations.

33 (3) Asian American and Pacific Islander Month

34 (May)

- 35 • The Asian American Cultural Heritage
- 36 Showcase by the Office of Multicultural
- 37 Affairs and the Asian American
- 38 Ambassadors;
- 39 • Events partnering with the Office of
- 40 Multicultural Affairs, Asian American
- 41 Ambassadors, or other student
- 42 organizations.

43 (4) Hispanic Heritage Month (September 15 –

- 45 • Talk Series by the Office of Multicultural
