*To amend the Student Government Code regarding Responsibilities of the  
FLC Director*

### *Enacted,*

#### 1 Amend:

#### 2 TITLE VIII Ch. 04 § 304. Responsibilities of the Director

3 The responsibilities of the director shall include, but not be limited to:  
4 planning the composition of the council meetings before the fall semester;  
5 executing the small group leader interview and application process, leading  
6 the meeting of the council; meeting with the branch heads to discuss master  
7 plans as necessary; and informing the executive and legislative officers of any  
8 updates no less than twice per semester at respective meetings.

12 The responsibilities of the director shall include, but not be limited to:  
13 planning the composition of the council meetings before the fall semester;  
14 executing the small group leader interview and application process, leading

16 plans as necessary; shall remain neutral on the topic of all student government  
17 elections; this includes, but not limited to not expressing support of any


18 individual candidates and, or tickets; excluding their own candidacy; shall be  
19 responsible for maintaining that the Freshman Leadership Council meetings  
20 remain neutral and unbiased in regards to student government elections; and  
21 informing the executive and legislative officers of any updates no less than  
22 twice per semester at respective meetings.

24 THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT AFTER THE VALIDATION OF THE  
25 SPRING 2022 ELECTION UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3)  
26 VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE  
27 PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF  
28 VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE  
29 SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
