**A Resolution**

*To Urge and Request* that the University Registrar  
halts the reimplementation of a policy that limits  
departments to scheduling no more than 55% of their  
course sections within prime-time hours

- 3 WHEREAS, Louisiana State University has promulgated the
- 4 student body's expectation that classes should take place
- 5 during prime-time hours; and
- 6
- 7 WHEREAS, the drastic increase in the University's student
- 8 body should not have a detrimental impact on current
- 9 Students; and
- 10
- 11 WHEREAS, Students have oriented their lives and schedules
- 12 around regular academic hours; and
- 13
- 14 WHEREAS, academic hours should enable students to work
- 15 outside of class in order for students to pay for the exorbitant
- 16 increases in tuition over the past decade; and
- 17
- 18 WHEREAS, the previous enforcement of the rule before the
- 19 vast majority of students were at the University does not
- 20 alone justify its reimplementation; and
- 21
- 22 WHEREAS, regardless if departments start moving in the
- 23 direction of non-typical hours to accommodate the increased

24 student population, a hard rule to enforce that conclusion  
25 stymies potential flexibility; and

27 WHEREAS, Louisiana State University needs to find a  
28 workable solution to accommodate the increased student  
29 population that also accounts for quality of life and  
30 education; and

32 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA  
33 STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE, that Student  
34 Government urges and requests that the University Registrar  
35 halts the reimplementation of a policy that limits departments to  
36 scheduling no more than 55% of their course sections within  
37 prime-time hours

39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS  
40 RESOLUTION BE SUBMITTED TO Faculty Senate and the  
41 University Registrar.

43 THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON  
44 PASSAGE by a simple majority (one-half plus one) vote of  
45 the LSU Student Senate and signature by the Student Body  
46 President, upon lapse of time for presidential action, or if  
47 vetoed by the President and subsequently approved by the  
48 Senate, on the date of such approval.
