A Resolution

*To Urge and Request Louisiana State University to
implement a virtual TigerCard system*

- 1 WHEREAS, several campuses such as the University of
- 2 Alabama, Auburn University, Clemson University, New
- 3 Mexico State University, the University of Tennessee,
- 4 Arizona University have already implemented this
- 5 feature; and
- 6 WHEREAS, there are multiple benefits of having a mobile
- 7 TigerCard system such as increased durability, accessibility,
- 8 and security; and
- 9 WHEREAS, students would not have to worry about having
- 10 to replace TigerCards after damage from typical usage; and
- 11 WHEREAS, students would be able to access dorms and
- 12 buildings more conveniently and efficiently; and
- 13 WHEREAS, this would alleviate the common occurrence of
- 14 being locked out of the dorms, which creates a huge safety
- 15 issue for students; and
- 16 WHEREAS, mobile TigerCards would add more security in
- 17 creating an additional layer of defense against theft or
- 18 loss; and
- 19 WHEREAS, having the option to use a virtual TigerCard
- 20 would potentially decrease the amount of plastic to move
- 21 towards the LSU Campus Sustainability's mission "to
- 22 become more efficient and environmentally responsible" in
- 23 its operations; and

24 WHEREAS, a physical TigerCard will still be shipped to all
 25 incoming students and the first physical TigerCard will still
 26 be free to students.

28 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA
 29 STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE, that LSU
 30 Administration implement a virtual tiger card system.

32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS
 33 RESOLUTION BE SUBMITTED TO Tyler Kearney, Associate
 34 Vice President for Finance & Administration, and Kimberly
 35 Lewis, Executive Vice President of Finance & Administration
 36 and Chief Administrative Officer.

38 THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON
 39 PASSAGE by a simple majority (one-half plus one) vote of
 40 the LSU Student Senate and signature by the Student Body
 41 President, upon lapse of time for presidential action, or if
 42 vetoed by the President and subsequently approved by the
 43 Senate, on the date of such approval.
