- 1 WHEREAS, SILVER WINGS IS A NATIONAL, CO-ED,
- 2 PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATION DEDICATED TO CREATING
- 3 PROACTIVE, KNOWLEDGEABLE, AND EFFECTIVE CIVIC LEADERS
- 4 THROUGH COMMUNITY SERVICE AND EDUCATION ABOUT
- 5 NATIONAL DEFENSE; AND
- 6 WHEREAS, LSU'S FRANK S. HAGAN SILVER WINGS CHAPTER
- 7 RE-ACTIVATED IN THE SPRING OF 2022 AND IS IN THE PROCESS OF
- 8 ACTIVATING A TIGER LINK ACCOUNT SEPARATE FROM THEIR
- 9 PARTNER ORGANIZATION ARNOLD AIR SOCIETY; AND
- 10 WHEREAS, HURRICANE IAN RAKED A PATH OF DESTRUCTION
- 11 ACROSS THE SOUTHEAST UNITED STATES ON SEPTEMBER 28,
- 12 2022, DEVASTATING THE STATE OF FLORIDA AND ITS GULF COAST;

- 14 WHEREAS, THE FIRST LARGE SERVICE EVENT LSU SILVER
- 15 WINGS HAS UNDERTAKEN IS A HURRICANE IAN RELIEF DRIVE
- 16 AFTER SPEAKING WITH FORT MYERS; AND
- 17 WHEREAS, IF TRAVEL FOR THIS INITIATIVE IS SECURED, THIS
- 18 INITIATIVE MAY EXPAND TO ALSO INCLUDE SILVER WINGS
- 19 CHAPTERS THROUGHOUT THE SOUTHEAST; AND

20 WHEREAS, THOSE INVOLVED WITH THE COLLECTION DRIVE
 21 HAVE EXPRESSED THEIR INTENTION TO INCLUDE STUDENT
 22 GOVERNMENT IN ALL ADVERTISING FOR AND PUBLICITY THIS

- 30 NEEDS: \$250




33 THEREFOR BE IT ENACTED THAT \$1931.00 OF THE STUDENT

 41 TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY
 42 THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY
