personal safety alarms*



- 1 WHEREAS, a personal safety alarm is an alarm that can be
- 2 clipped onto keys, backpacks, and lanyards that can be set
- 3 off by removing the pin (it also includes a flashlight for
- 4 walking in the dark); and
- 5 WHEREAS, this past semester the crime rate in Baton
- 6 Rouge has been very high and these alarms would help
- 7 make students feel more secure; and
- 8 WHEREAS, ordering 500 unites in bulk, the item would
- 9 cost \$3.69 per unit making the total, including tax and
- 10 shipping, come out to be \$2,133.56; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the alarm will include the LSU Student
- 12 Government Logo; and

- 14 THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED THAT the LSU Student
- 15 Senate appropriate a maximum of \$2,200.00 from the
- 16 initiatives account to fund 500 personal safety alarms

- 21 TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY
- 22 THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY
- 23 THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
